## Church Council Ministries Meeting Minutes February 20, 2024

In attendance: Karen Kaufman, John Reardon, Lori Whitehead, Trent Johnson, and Nancy McInnis. Lillian Harmon was a guest.

Call to order at 7:04 pm

We opened with prayer.

Lori Whitehead would like to add discussion regarding the water issue with the valve. Nancy McInnis made a motion to accept the agenda as amended. Trent Johnson seconded. Motion carried.

Previous minutes were presented. Lori Whitehead made a motion to accept the previous minutes as presented. Trent Johnson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Vice President's Report per Trent Johnson – nothing to report.

#### **BOARD REPORTS**

Elders & Call Committee: per Trent Johnson (Darryl Swainson is not in attendance) — Darryl informed Trent that they are potentially looking to add a fourth pastor into the rotation. This pastor was originally listed to be put on the call list. Trent and John Reardon will be presenting a letter to the council that we would like to send out to the congregation regarding the open positions on the various boards. The dual parish call committee has met several times with folks from the district and Pastor Moyer. It was discussed that our congregation needs to step up a bit to perform the duties normally completed by a full time pastor such as Bible Study for example. A lay person within our congregation can do Bible Study. Our boards also have quite a few openings and these openings need to be filled. The issue is, if we don't step up, we may not be able to get anyone to fill our dual pastor role.

Council looked over the letter we would like to send out and some spelling errors were corrected and John updated his copy to reflect those changes. Everyone agreed that with the changes the letter is good to be sent out. There will be several ways to sign up for a board position as well.

Family & Youth: per Debbie LoCascio - nothing to report. Still deciding about an Easter Egg Hunt.

Gospel Outreach: per John Reardon - We will pick up on this when we have a pastor to work with.

<u>Human Care</u>: per Karen Kaufman – sent out some Valentine cards last week to the nursing home. We have the St. Paul's dinner coming up. Since Pastor Jung has taken a call, we are going to contact St. Paul to see how this will go.

<u>Parish Fellowship</u> per Nancy McInnis – Pot Luck for Debbie LoCascio's retirement. Lillian Harmon will put the sign up board in the entryway. Trent Johnson offered to accept the donations for a gift for Debbie.

Last year the Easter breakfast did not have a lot of attendees so we decided to not do one this year. They decided to stuff some eggs with candy and put them out for any kids in attendance.

<u>Properties</u>: per Trent Johnson (Joshua Cook was not in attendance) – Lori Whitehead contacted two plumbers and they both stood her up. The toilets are fixed in the men's room which was causing the large water bill but now but the valves need to be replaced as we are unable to shut off the water in the event of a leak.

Per Trent we are still looking for folks to mow this summer.

LWML: per Leslie Oehring via notes – just working on the quilts.

New Secretary Update – the council welcomed Lillian to St. Mark's.
