The midweek Lenten services that follow Ash Wednesday will be held at 3 of our sister churches—Peace Waterford, Faith Highland, and Christ Milford—at 7:00 p.m. (pastoral preaching schedule to be determined). The pastors of those congregations will be rotating in a roundrobin style and parishioners are encouraged to select ONE location to attend so that they get to see/hear all 3 pastors preach over the 5 week Lenten period. Please attend, if you can!

Please join us for Holy Week Worship Services!

Throughout the season of Lent, we have been solemnly preparing our hearts and minds through meditation on God's Word, that e might celebrate with highest joy in the death and resurrection of Jesus -- the culminating moment of our salvation. In March, we will reach the fulfillment of this season of preparation as we enter into Holy week. During this week, we will have several special services.

First, on **Sunday, March 24**, we will observe Palm/ Passion Sunday. On this day, we remember our Lord's Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem, when He rode on a donkey into the city while the crowd laid palm branches on the road before Him. The service on this day will be held at the normal time, **9:30 a.m.**, and will include a reading of the Passion account, which tells the story of Jesus' suffering and death.

Then, on **Thursday, March 28**, we will observe Maundy Thursday. On this day, we remember our Lord's



Church Council Business Meeting Minutes - Summarized January 16, 2024

In attendance: Karen Kaufman, John Reardon, Darryl Swainson, Trent Johnson, and Nancy McInnis

Call to order at 7:00 pm

We opened with prayer.

Treasurer's Report – Kyle Albert not in attendance. Trent Johnson advised that the \$50,000 was moved over to a CD and is now showing up on the financial report. It has grown by about \$600. We also got rid of the investments accounts that were losing money each month.

Vice President's Report Per Trent: We are still averaging 40 people per Sunday.

BOARD REPORTS

Elders & Call Committee per Darryl Swainson -

- Regarding Ash Wednesday/Lent our Circuit pastors are working to put together a round robin schedule for the midweek
 Lent services. No moving from church to church like Advent. We would select one church to attend. Christ Milford, Faith
 Highland or Peach Waterford for all midweek services. That way we would see all three pastors. Pastor Moyer will send
 us the schedule when it is finished. Ash Wednesday begins on February 14. It was suggested that we select one of the
 churches that we would consider the dual parish with and attend their services for Lent.
- We have the confirmation class going and Darryl will be calling to see how that is going.

<u>Human Care</u> per Karen Kaufman –

- Debbie LoCascio would like to put the Lenten coin holders out soon and the proceeds would go to Joe Boway again.
- On January 21 we will celebrate the Transfiguration of our Lord festival.
- We are also making Valentine cards for the nursing homes.

Properties per Trent Johnson (Joshua Cook was not in attendance) -

- the water leak continues to be an issue. Lori Whitehead was going to use a plumber that she used in the past but that has not worked out so she will continue to work on this.
- The sanctuary windows will be repaired in the spring when it is warmer.
- The plow truck stopped working this past weekend. We were able to find someone to plow the lot for \$300. Realistically we will need to purchase a new truck. We will try to make it through this winter and look for something in the spring/ summer.

LWML per Leslie Oehring via notes – the Quilting Bee will resume on February 1.

NEW BUSINESS

Call Committee Update – the Committee will be meeting with Pastor Meckes (MI District) and Pastor Moyer (our Circuit Visitor) tomorrow night to further discuss the Dual Parish (or Multipoint) pastor option. Hopefully we will have constructive conversation and get this moving.

Hiring of new Secretary Update – after reviewing the duties of the office manager and the secretary's duties, it is obvious that we will need a full time person, especially if we go with a dual parish pastor. The person who was interested in the part time position is not interested in anything full time. There is someone interested in the full time position and she has church office experience in both LCMS and ELCA churches. John Reardon, Trent Johnson and Debbie LoCascio will interview her some time this week.
