TOILETRY/HYGIENE DONATIONS FOR THE OPEN DOOR OUTREACH CENTER

◆ We continue to receive hygiene & toilet-ry products year around for the Open Door Outreach Center in Waterford. There are two bins located on the shelves at the bottom of the sanctuary stairs where you can place product donations. The Open Door is a non-profit organization that assists needy families in the Lakes Area. They are ALWAYS in need of toiletry and hygiene items, so **if you can provide any of these throughout the year, it would be appreciated.**

WE CONTINUE TO COLLECT used post-age stamps for Wycliffe Bible Translation Ministries, and used eyeglasses for MOST Ministries in the two plastic bins on the shelves at the bottom of the sanctuary stairs. Wycliffe sells the stamps to stamp collectors and then uses the proceeds to fund Bible translation projects throughout the world. MOST Ministries repairs/refurbishes used eyeglasses and distributes them via eyeglass clinics to the needy around the world. If you donate postage stamps, please leave ¼” of the paper around the stamp.

Collecting Bottles/Cans for Ziah Town School

If you would like to donate your returnable cans and bottles, the Board of Human Care is accepting them weekly! Just bring your bag to church and an usher will let you know where you can put them. A member of the Human Care Board will collect them and make the return. All money will then go into the fund for the Ziah Town Liberian Lutheran School to be used for catechisms

and/or school supplies. You may also make donations at any time by either putting your check/cash in a green envelope and writing “Joe Boway” on the front (checks made payable to St. Mark’s), or visiting the St. Mark’s website, clicking the online giving button and selecting the fund titled Joe Boway/Liberian School.

THE FATHER'S HANDS FOOD PANTRY AND CLOTHING CLOSET at St. Paul's Community Lutheran Church has been very busy this spring. They have served over 300 families in the pantry alone since January. This has led to a depletion of their supplies. They are in urgent need for the following items:

- Powdered milk - 1qt envelopes or boxes
- Plain pasta - macaroni
- Spaghetti Noodles
- Spaghetti Sauce
- Non-starchy canned vegetables
- Peas, Corn or mixed vegetables
- Soups, Rice, Baked beans
- Protein bars
- Instant Potatoes
- Canned Tuna or Chicken
- Toilet paper, Tooth Paste, Hand sanitizer,
- Large bars of soap and diapers (size 5)

For Larger families they need:

- Family sized shampoo & conditioner
- Large cans of baked beans
- Large can of fruit
- large can of vegetables
- Large Rice, dried potatoes or spaghetti noodles
- large cans of chicken or meat that will serve 5 or more.
- Laundry detergent
- Dishwashing soap
- Dried soup that serve 8 or more.

interesting events as of this Past Sunday: We were without a organist and couldn't find a replacement. Pastor Pies, vacancy Pastor discovered Pastor Vieker, former Pastor, was in town and contacted him and asked to play the organ; He agreed. Darryl proposed a monetary gift of \$150., to be given to Pastor Vieker for playing on the 19th of May to show our appreciation even though he originally said no for payment. Motion was made and unanimously approved.

The Office will be putting an emergency contact notebook together of people to contact, within the congregation and outside, with direction for preapproved contacts if no one else is available at the time to handle emergencies such as: Pastors not able to make service, last second organists, building problems, etc.
